### **Borden Youth Centre – Rules and Expectations**

While attending the Borden Youth Centre, youth and staff have the right to feel safe, welcome, and respected at all times. To help ensure that a comfortable, safe, and respectful atmosphere is upheld at the Borden Youth Centre, the following policies have been put into place:

- **01)** Improper behaviour of any kind is unacceptable. Loud and unruly arguments; cyberbullying/harassment; name calling; threats; physical, verbal and/or sexual harassment; inappropriate physical contact (i.e., HANDS ON) and/or any other signs of bullying will NOT be tolerated.
- **02)** Respect yourself & others. Degrading racial, ethnic, sexist, homophobic remarks and swearing are not welcome at the Borden Youth Centre.
- **03)** Respect ALL PSP employees, and personal property around you. Any individual who *deliberately* abuses, misuses, or breaks equipment will be required to pay for an identical or comparable replacement. The Military Police will be contacted for any vandalism. If equipment is broken *unintentionally*, please let the Borden Youth Centre staff know immediately.
- **05)** Gossiping and/or speaking disrespectfully about others is not allowed at the Borden Youth Centre. Speak for yourself and not for others.
- **06)** There is zero tolerance for the possession, selling and/or use of tobacco products, alcoholic beverages or any other harmful or illegal substance.
- **07)** There will be no smoking in or around the Centre or within 100m of the building.
- **08)** Room volume must remain at a comfortable level for staff, youth and other individuals in the building. Offensive music (including music with inappropriate language) will not be permitted at the Youth Centre.
- **09)** Clean up after yourself. This includes any garbage and recyclable items as well as personal items.
- **10)** Dangerous or harmful objects are prohibited. This includes, but is not limited to guns, knives, razors, air soft guns, etc. Individuals found in violation of this policy will be banned. In most cases, guardians and the MP's will be notified.
- **11)** There is no loitering in the front of the Borden Youth Centre.



## **Borden Youth Centre Three Strike Policy**

The Borden Youth Centre's three-strike policy applies to all youth participants who attend the PSP Borden Youth Centre. If a youth fails to abide by the policies and expectations the following three (3) steps will be carried out by Youth Centre staff:

**Strike 1**: The youth involved will be asked to leave the Youth Centre for the remainder of the day/night. If the youth consistently fails to listen to staff and does not leave the centre, they will be asked to leave for the remainder of the day/night and will not be permitted to attend the following day/night that the Youth Centre is open. Parents/Guardians will be notified immediately if strike 1 is implemented.

**Strike 2**: If similar improper behaviour continues when the youth returns to the Youth Centre, the youth will be sent home immediately and suspended from attending the Youth Centre for four (4) Youth Centre days/nights. Parents/Guardians will be notified immediately if strike 2 is implemented.

**Strike 3**: If similar improper behaviour continues following strike 2, this youth will be permanently suspended from the Youth Centre, or suspended until the youth, along with a parent or guardian, meets with the Recreation Coordinator to discuss alternative options.

By signing this document, I (the youth participant) acknowledge that I have read and understand the Borden Youth Centre Policies and Expectations and Three Strike Policy and will abide by all aforementioned policies to ensure that the Youth Centre is a safe place for all youth and staff to attend.
