	Previous mess minutes were read by the PMC Motion to accept the Previous Mess Minutes by MS Lefrense 2 nd by MS Ryan	PMC
3.	Financial Statement	
	PMC reviewed Financial Statement with MS Moores PMC stated that although the mess has over \$300,000 in NPF, we are spending more every month than what is covered with mess dues, and should be aware of this when making large purchases. Motion to accept the Financial Statement by MS Longmire 2 nd by MS Nash	PMC

	<p><u>Popcorn Machine</u> There is a new popcorn machine in Slackers.</p> <p><u>Furniture</u> PMC stated the companies contacted for new furniture failed to provide quotes before the financial year cutoff date. The search for new furniture quotes is ongoing.</p> <p><u>New Deck</u> The PMC had MS Lefrense explain that there are new journeymen being posted in that will build the new deck, and that he will accept volunteers for sand-removal mid-Dec so the project can be started. The deck should be completed for spring and a deck-opening event will be tied in with Spring-fest.</p>	PMC

	<p>PMC stated there has been interest in the mess buying tickets and passes to hand out to members for sports and events; such as Martock passes, more Mooseheads tickets (although the ones we have are not all given out), and Thunderbirds tickets.</p> <p>Motion by MS Lefrense for NMT \$6500 on Thunderbirds tickets. 2nd by S1 Soper. Motion PASSED.</p> <p>Motion by S1 Lucy for NMT \$2700 for Martock passes. 2nd by MS Harris-Fallon. Motion PASSED.</p> <p>MS Harris-Fallon mentioned Martock has a tab system that can be set up through the mess for up to a pre-designated amount of money to cut down on buying passes that may not be used. PMC is going to contact Martock to consider options.</p> <p>Motion by MS Lefrense for NMT \$5000 per year for tournament prizes. 2nd by MS Richards. Motion PASSED.</p> <p>--</p> <p>PMC stated the new Constitution and By-Laws are almost completed. The 2 documents are now separated and easier to follow/know what the mess can and cannot vote to change. Motion by MS Lefrense to vote in changes to the Constitution (once approved) via email voting. 2nd by MS Richards. 	<p>PMC opened the floor to any questions or concerns from the membership.</p> <p>The PMC read and discussed some of the entries to the suggestion box. This included concerns that the bar manager was only firing the female bartenders, which the PMC explained how and why this was not the case.</p> <p>There were comments about PSP being the bar managers for the messes, which the PMC also discussed with the members.</p> <p>Member suggestions included that there should be more family-oriented events, which the PMC stated that children are not allowed in Slackers but would be happy to take suggestions on events if more event detail ideas were given.</p> <p>The PMC addressed more issues with the new bar hours, explaining that they were changed due to orders from the Base Commander, not from the Executive Committee or PSP.</p> <p>--</p> <p>Motion by MS Lefrense for NMT \$45,000 on the purchase of a golf simulator, with membership to vote electronically before purchase. 2nd by MS Poole. Motion PASSED.</p> <p>--</p> <p>PMC stated there were complaints that not enough pizzas were being ordered on Wednesday. Explained that the number of people that come for pizzas changes weekly, but will order 5 more per week. The PMC will also look into order some vegan and lactose intolerant options going forward.</p> <p>--</p> <p>The Kid's Christmas Party will be in Mr. Mac's on 07 Dec 2025 1100-1400. There will not be presents this year, but will have a Santa, snacks, and activities.</p>
