Public Skating: Code of Conduct

Participants and spectators agree to and accept responsibility for the following:

1. Abide by posted signs and warnings and cooperate with PSP staff.
2. Do not enter ice surface when ice maintenance is taking place.
3. Persons under the age of 12 years must be under the care and control of a person 18 years of age or older while participating in public skating.
4. Public skates will have one ice attendant or patroller for every 59 participants.
5. Equipment Regulations / Restrictions:
 - a. Ice skates required: **STREET SHOES NOT PERMITTED ON THE ICE.**
 - b. Persons under the age of 12 years must wear a CSA approved helmet: Bicycle helmets not permitted.
 - c. Sleds, toboggans, baby strollers and any type of hockey equipment (sticks, pucks, etc.) are not permitted on the ice.
 - d. Wheelchairs and ice sledges are permitted on the ice.
6. Skaters Shall Not:
 - a. Bring food or drink on the ice surface.
 - b. Carry children or items while skating.
 - c. Play hockey during public skating.
 - d. Skate in groups or obstruct others.
 - e. Skate while under the influence of drugs, alcohol or other control impairing substances.
 - f. Sit on dasher boards.
7. Skaters Shall:
 - a. Maintain their awareness, control their speed and direction.
 - b. Keep exits clear.
 - c. Exit the ice surface if a whistle blows.
 - d. Report hazards to the Arena Operator.
 - e. Report accidents or injuries to the PSP staff, prior to leaving the facility.
8. Wearing headphones, listening to a personal musical device or talking / texting on a cell phone while skating is not recommended.
