

Activities at Arrowhead - Rules and Regulations for Use

1. Operational Timings:

Mon	Tue	Wed	Thu	Fri	Sat	Sun

2. This fair weather activity will cease at any time the following occurs:

- ✓ Rain (that can impact safety and visibility)
- ✓ Risk of imminent thunderstorm
- ✓ Moderate Breeze (11-15 knots) and above (please see Wind Speed Guidelines)
- ✓ Rough / rolling water / white caps
- ✓ If Air Horn sounds. (All users must return to the beach immediately due to safety).

3. **All users MUST have a Military ID or Base Gym membership. Must show ID.**

- a. Family of a Military member are permitted to use equipment when accompanied by member with a Military ID.

4. Users aged 13-16 years are permitted to use equipment while accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.

5. Users aged 12 years and under are not permitted to be on their own piece of equipment. They are permitted to use a double kayak only when accompanied by a parent or legal guardian in the kayak with them.

6. **All users MUST sign a waiver prior to being issued any type of equipment.** Those who are 17 years and under must have the parent or legal guardian sign the waiver on their behalf. The child's name must be clearly identified.

7. All users MUST use all safety equipment provided (PFD, safety boat kits)

8. No user is allowed in the trailer unless invited to assist by the PSP attendant.

9. All users are to stay within the defined area. (See attached map)

10. Users are not to enter the Yacht Club boat dock area and must stay a minimum of 15 feet away from the boats and moorings in the Bay at all times.

Note: PSP employees are permitted to use the Activities at Arrowhead service – however, proper photo ID must be provided.
