Are you a compassionate mental health professional ready to make a real difference in the lives of Military families during critical transitions? The Mainland BC MFRC is seeking a Registered Clinical Counsellor or Registered Social Worker to join our team as our Family Liaison Officer.

THE ROLE: You'll provide specialized psychosocial support and navigation to families of medically releasing CAF members—helping them manage the complex emotional, practical, and systemic challenges of transition. This isn't general counselling; it's targeted, transition-focused support during one of the most difficult periods in a Military family's journey.

WHAT YOU'LL DO

- Provide short-term, evidence-based counselling and crisis intervention
- Support families navigating medical release, VAC benefits, and community resources
- Collaborate with interdisciplinary teams (VAC, CAF medical staff, PSP)
- Participate in clinical supervision and professional development

WHAT YOU NEED

- RCC/CCC or RSW registration in BC (required)
- 2+ years post-graduate clinical experience
- Crisis intervention and family-centred counselling skills
- Strong professional boundaries and understanding of multi-stakeholder environments
- Experience with military/Veteran families (asset)

- \$48/hr to start, \$50/hr after probation
- Health & dental benefits
- 3 weeks paid vacation (prorated)
- Paid professional registration
- Clinical supervision & professional development
- Flexible scheduling (3 days/week, typically Mon-Fri 9am-4:30pm)
