JOINING INSTRUCTIONS – ST-JEAN GOLF QUALIFICATION TOURNAMENT

1. SITUATION

The purpose of the tournament is to determine the members who will form the Montréal Region Patriots team (6 men and 3 women) for the upcoming CAF Regional Golf Competition, which will take place from 13 to 16 July 2026 in Ottawa, ON.

2. MISSION

The qualification will take place on Monday 8 June and Tuesday 9 June 2026 at ***Club de Golf de Saint-Jean, Saint-Jean-sur-Richelieu, QC, located at 320 rue Jacques-Cartier Sud, J3B 4J7.*** The first tee time will be at 1300 hrs, followed by groups every 9 minutes. Activities will be supervised by the PSP Military Sports team.

3. EXECUTION

a. Eligibility. Open to active Regular Force and Reserve Force military personnel from the Montréal Region. Each participant must have no medical restrictions, possess a valid FORCE evaluation, and must not be on leave for the entire duration of the event (qualification and regional competition).

- **Men:** Proof of a round with a score of 110 or less from the Blue tees must be submitted.
- **Women:** Proof of a round with a score of 140 or less from the Red tees must be submitted.
- Your scorecard must be signed by a partner or the marshal from the golf course.

b. Schedule. Activities will begin at **1300 hrs at Club de Golf de Saint-Jean** Participants may arrive earlier to hit practice balls. The final schedule will be determined once registrations are completed.



c. Description of activities :

- Mandatory Teams meeting on **Wednesday 3 June 2026 at 1130 hrs** [here](#).
- Twoday competition: **8 and 9 June 2026** – you must be present on both days to qualify for the regional competition.
- Foursomes will be determined based on the scorecards submitted in advance. Your tee time will be emailed one week prior to the qualification.
- Participants must submit their results to the PSP staff on site at the end of their round.

d. Dress code. Participants must wear attire that complies with the dress regulations of Club de Golf du Parcours du Cerf.

e. Registration. Interested individuals may register as follows:

- Have the sports authorization request signed by their Unit CO.
- Submit a proof of play that meets the eligibility criteria.
- Submit all the documents signed and finalized, no later than **Friday May 22nd, 2026** to SvcOpsSportsMilitairesRegionMontreal@forces.gc.ca and to Philippe.Daneau@forces.gc.ca.
