



Local Rules for the Golf Qualification

- Every group will have a PSP with them to assure the flow of the game and make sure the rules are being followed.
- You will need to give your game card at the end of the first day.
- Accepted GPS machines must only read distance.
 - If a player uses a GPS device able to evaluate or measure other conditions that can affect his play (slope, wind speed, temperature, etc.), the player commits an infraction to the rule 14-3 and the penalty is disqualification, no matter if the additional functions were used or not.
- No cell phones are permitted on the course, not even in the bag.
 - If you have a cell phone with during one of the rounds, the penalty will be an automatic disqualification.
- The max amount of time for a round is 4h30. Follow the group preceding you.
 - If your group is out of position, the rules official will give the group a verbal warning. Your group is now on the clock. If the group doesn't get back in position, the slow player or players will receive a (1) stroke penalty. If the slow play continues, the player or players will receive a (2) stroke penalty. The next action will be disqualification.
- Before your start time, exchange your score card with another player to keep track of his score.
 - Player 1 scores 2, player 2 scores 3 and player 3 scores 1.
- No one is allowed on the Golf court, except on the kart zone with a reasonable distance.
- The Canadian Armed Forces follow Golf Canada rules. You can download the R&A, Rules of Golf application to have access to the rules.
