CIBOURE, FRANCE

Enjoy the magnificent view of the bay of Saint-Jean de Luz from the terrace of this quaint renovated first floor apartment in Basque Country. Whether you enjoy exploring the old towns, strolling along the beaches or hiking in the mountains, there is so much to see and discover in the area. The beaches and towns of St Jean de Luz and Socca are only a ten minute walk away and Spain is only a ten minute drive away. The Sunday morning market is not to be missed!

Ciboure shares its bay with Saint-Jean-de-Luz and from the Larraldenia marina a promenade runs along the water's edge to Socoa. Whether you are on foot or cycling, the Vélodyssée enables you to go around the bay and discover the beautiful red and green painted facades of the Labourdine-style houses on Quai Ravel.

PLACES OF INTEREST

St Jean de Luz: Three minutes by car or ten minutes on foot takes you to the town of St Jean de Luz. Stroll through the narrow streets in the historic centre. The two thalassotherapy centres, Hélianthal by Thalazur and Loreamar, are located on the front line of the Grande Plage in Saint-Jean-de-Luz.

Socoa: Three minutes by car or ten minutes on foot, Socoa is A favourite spot for nautical activities. You will also find many excellent restaurants behind a plethora of colourful curtains on the edge of the small port. Here you will also find two supervised beaches.

Golf: The Chantaco Golf Club in St Jean de Luz is an 18-hole course open all year round, alternating between 9 wooded holes and 9 more technical holes. Practise your favourite activity a stone's throw from the ocean in an exceptional setting. The Nivelle Golf Club located in the heart of the town of Ciboure, is an 18-hole course (par 70). A unique, typically British course, very varied and hilly, allowing you to discover superb panoramas: the ocean, the Nivelle, the port of Saint Jean-de-Luz and the Pyrenees.

Guéthary: Guéthary, a traditional village located between Bidart and Saint-Jean-de-Luz, is a haven of peace on the doorstep of Basque coastal towns. An art of living that embraces nature, tradition and "the good life" at the water's edge awaits you on every street corner and detour down Guéthary's narrow streets.

Urrugne: The village of Urrugne is fortunate to extend from the ocean with the Basque Corniche to the first mountains of the Pyrenees. The village has preserved its traditions and architecture and offers many outdoor activities.



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DESCRIPTION OF THE PROPERTY
