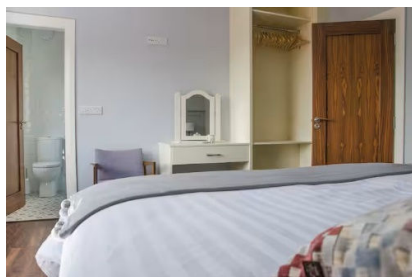


SUMMER PROGRAM

Killarney, a picturesque town in County Kerry, Ireland, sits on the northeastern shore of Lough Leane within Killarney National Park. PLACES OF INTEREST:

Killarney National Park (1km): A stunning natural park featuring lakes, mountains, and woodlands. It's ideal for hiking, cycling, and nature walks.

Muckcross House and Gardens (6km): A beautiful Victorian mansion set amidst spectacular gardens, offering a glimpse into the past.

Ross Castle (3km): A 15th-century tower house on the edge of Lough Leane, providing guided tours and picturesque views.

Torc Waterfall (7km): A breathtaking waterfall located in the National Park, perfect for a scenic hike.

Gap of Dunloe (12km): A narrow mountain pass offering dramatic landscapes, popular for walking and pony trekking.

Killarney House and Gardens (1km): An elegant estate with beautifully landscaped gardens, situated in the heart of Killarney town.

St. Mary's Cathedral (1km): A magnificent 19th-century Gothic-style cathedral, notable for its impressive architecture and serene ambiance.

Ladies View (19km): A famous viewpoint offering panoramic views of the lakes and mountains of Killarney National Park.

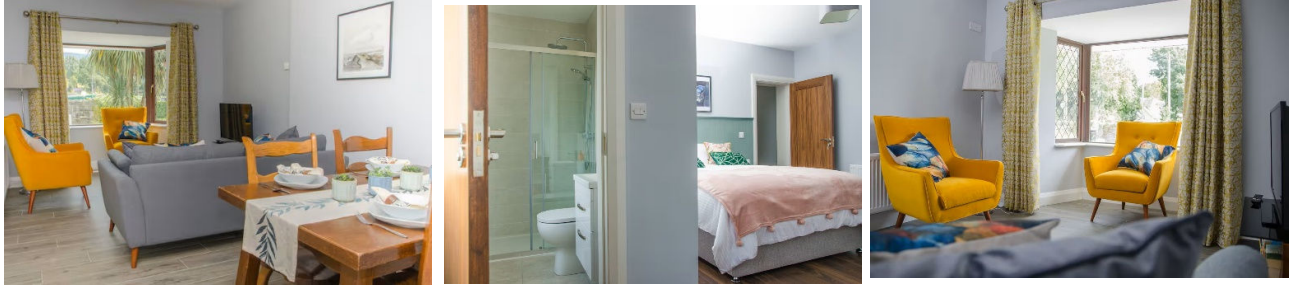
Innisfallen Island (4km): An island on Lough Leane, home to the ruins of a 7th-century monastery, accessible by boat.

MacGillycuddy's Reeks (15km): Ireland's highest mountain range, perfect for adventurous hikers seeking breathtaking scenery.

Moll's Gap (19km): A mountain pass on the Ring of Kerry, offering stunning views of the surrounding countryside.

Aghadoe Heights (6km): A viewpoint overlooking the lakes of Killarney, featuring the ruins of an ancient church and round tower.





DESCRIPTION OF THE APARTMENT

Airport: Kerry Airport (KIR) (21.8 km) from Killarney
