# CHALET MARTAGON CHAMONIX VALLEY, FRANCE

Chalet Martagon, located in the Chamonix valley, is on the ground floor of a traditionally built wooden chalet. It is situated in a private garden from where you can start exploring the region, breathe in the alpine air and soak up the breathtaking scenery.

The quaint little alpine town of Chamonix is found in the shadows of Mont Blanc's majestic snowcapped peak. Chamonix has been a world-renowned ski destination ever since the Winter Olympics of 1924. The Chamonix Valley is considered by many to be the best freeride resort in the world. With its 5 ski resorts; Grands Montets, Les Houches, Le Tour/Balme, La Flégère and Le Brévent; Chamonix Mont-Blanc offers the perfect ski holiday. The many different ski areas cater to all levels, from beginners to extreme skiers. For non-skiers, the area also offers many other winter activities including ice skating, dog sledding, tobogganing, snow shoeing... Simply put a winter wonderland for all ages!

You may also choose to discover the delightful, rustic atmosphere of cozy chalet restaurants. Savor delicious meals of authentic Savoy cuisine; hearty country cooking based on potatoes, cheese and charcuterie; and specialties like fondue and raclette. All satisfying meals after a long day on the slopes or hiking in the mountains.

#### **PLACES OF INTEREST:**

Mont Blanc (10km): Mont Blanc is the highest peak in Western Europe reaching an altitude of 4,810 m.

Glacier "Mer de glace" (10 km): The "Mer de Glace" is one of the largest glaciers in Europe. The glacier spans 7 km in length and offers spectacular scenery. A must see…

<u>Aiguilles du midi (9km)</u>: For more than 50 years, the most famous and highest of the Aiguilles de Chamonix has been a world attraction. From the centre of Chamonix, a 20 minutes ride in the Aiguille du Midi cable car takes you to the gateway to the high Alps. The Aiguille du Midi and its laid-out terraces offer a 360° view of all the French, Swiss and Italian Alps and a clear view of Mont Blanc.

<u>Château de Chillon (88km)</u>: The "Château de Chillon" dates from the 11<sup>th</sup> century and is the most visited historic building in Switzerland. It is located on a rocky islet on the shore of Lake Geneva.
