

Label the capital city of the province. Next, research British Columbia's topography and colour the map accordingly!




# Fly the Flag



The provincial flag of British Columbia was introduced in 1960, by Premier W. A. C. Bennett. The flag's key features include:


- Union Jack (top)
- Wavy, white & blue lines: symbolize BC's location between the Pacific Ocean and the Rocky Mountains.
- Setting sun: represents westernmost location in Canada, as well as the province's motto "splendor sine occasu" (beauty that never diminishes).


#### Provincial Fauna
