Label the capital city of the province. Next, research Quebec's topography and colour the map accordingly!






The provincial flag of Quebec was introduced on 21 January, 1948. The flag's key features include:

- White cross from the ancient royal flags of France
- white fleurs-de-lis: symbol of purity
- Blue field: symbolizes heaven
- The while fleurs-de-lis and the blue field come from a banner honouring the Virgin Mary
