5.	 NEW BUSINESS. a) Budget discussion: Budget was sent out ahead of the meeting to all members for them to consider. Main questions were about the cost item of 4 sets of stand alone badminton poles for \$2000. Explained that they are needed for our new venue, the South Side Community Centre. Also discussed the need for a cap on pickleball membership. Agreed one is needed but the number will be determined at a later date once we see if membership will increase as we suspect. Also agreed membership should continue for a rolling year from date of purchase. Motion to adopt the budget was made by France Banville and seconded by Jude Alexander. Motion carried. b) Schedule of Play Discussion: The schedule was sent out to all members ahead of the meeting for their consideration. Paul gave an explanation of all the venues and times listed (see attached schedule). Brendan was asked to see if our badminton club would be able to join with the Garrison badminton team on their practice nights. They often don't have enough players on any given night and so would be bolstered by our players. Active military members are given free membership to our club. If they were given Monday and Wednesday evenings for badminton and we were allowed to merge with them we could relinquish Friday night or Sunday morning. If this merger is not possible Brendan will check to see if our badminton club could use the South Side Community Centre on Monday evenings until the Recplex floor is repaired. c) Krisha Alexander was selected to be the Junior Badminton Program Director to help train juniors on our Wednesday evenings, 5:00-7:00, at the South Side Community Centre. d) John Glover motioned to adopt the new schedule with the potential alterations being investigated by Brendan Cunliffe.
