<p>5. It has been identified that the projected expenditures for FY 26/27 will not be sustainable. TGIT attendance has gradually increased steadily where it is now up to 75-80x members. The mitigation is to increase TGIT budget accordingly (up to \$1.5k per week with HST) or remain within previously approved TGIT expenditure limit with expectation that food quality will decline sharply. Three COAs were presented to either keep status quo and accept the reduction in qualities food based on attendance or increase mess dues. The dollar amounts in the COAs were \$25, \$28, and \$30 respectively with Sports tickets cancelled.
