The Mainland BC Military Family Resource Centre (MFRC) is seeking nominations to the Board of Directors.

We are looking for committed individuals who want to contribute to the BC military family community in a meaningful way and have a bit of time and energy to do so.

We ask that potential directors endeavour to make at least a 2-year commitment, if possible. Board members may be from Reserve Force, Regular Force, or Veteran families and may live anywhere in BC, exclusive of Vancouver Island.

As a governance board, the Mainland BC Military Family Resource Centre Board of Directors is responsible for providing leadership and oversight and for guiding the strategic direction of the organization. The board also provides guidance and support to the executive director, who is responsible for day-to-day management of the activities of the MFRC.

Other board member duties include:

- Strategic planning
- Financial oversight
- Risk management, including legal/regulatory compliance
- Promotion of the organization to increase the profile of the Military Family Resource Centre in both the military and civilian communities

The board typically meets 9 times per year (no meetings in December, July, August). Meetings last approximately 60 minutes, and board members may participate virtually. The board consists of a chair, vice-chair, secretary, treasurer (the executive committee), plus up to 5 more directors for maximum of 9 board members.
