

## CSMFRC Programming Expectations and Guidelines

The CSMFRC anticipates that events organized will be FUN and help our dependents to become great leaders. In order for us to be successful in this venture, we require the following expectations to be understood and reviewed by the dependents and their parents/guardians.

## **Expectations:**

- 1. Participants must follow the direction of CSMFRC staff and/or event hosts to ensure the safety of themselves and of the group.
- 2. Respectful behavior towards themselves, other participants, CSMFRC staff, event hosts, as well as the space they occupy is mandatory. Staff will attempt redirection techniques for inappropriate behaviour, within reason.
- 3. Vehicle use: Participants must stay seated, with their seatbelt fastened, and with their seats in the position deemed safe by the driver.

Failure to comply with these expectations may result in restriction of future CSMFRC opportunities and events. If participants are unable to meet expectations during an event and the coordinator is unable to proceed in a manner they believe to be safe for all participants, a parent or guardian may be contacted and required to pick up their dependent from the event.
